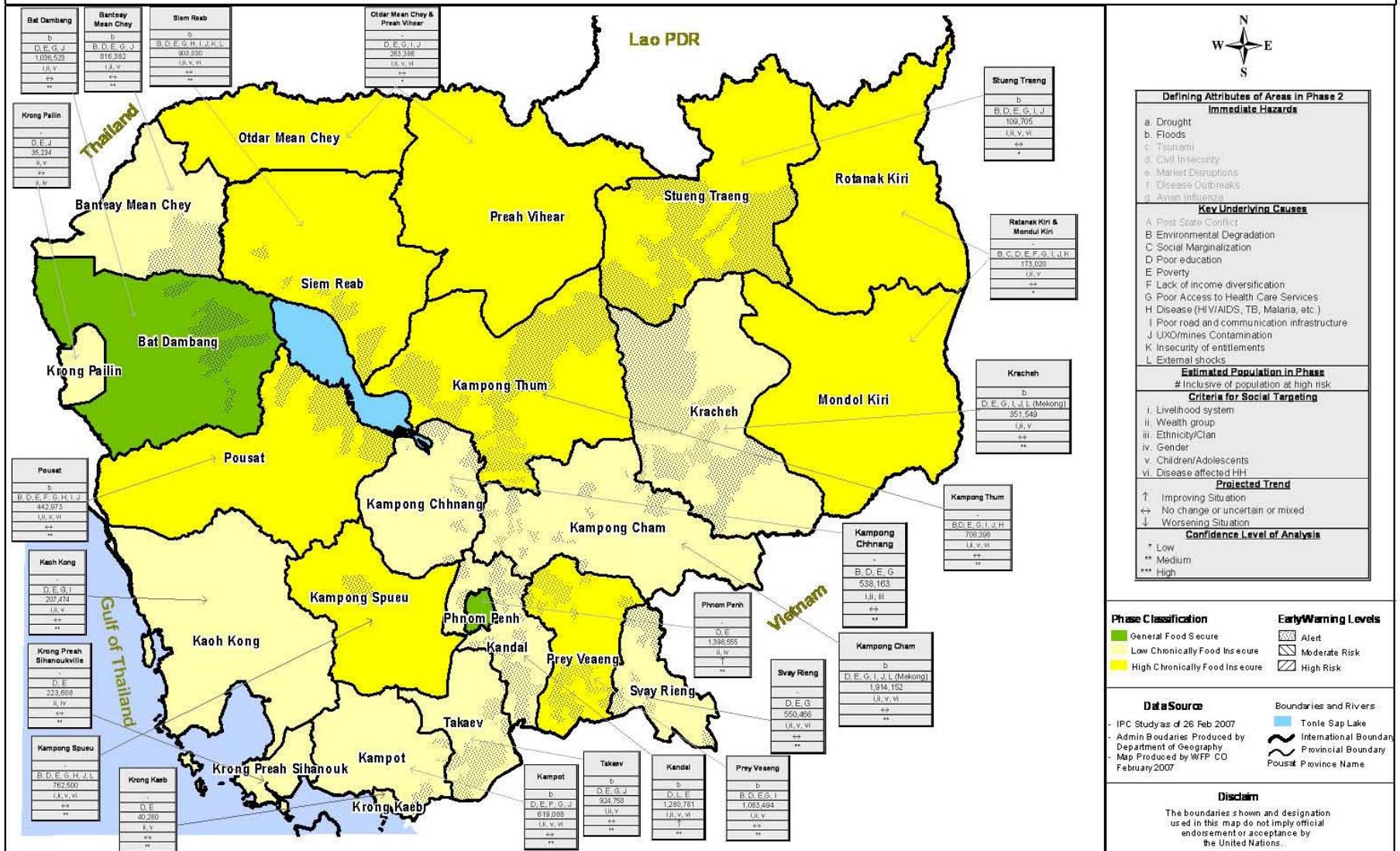


## Integrated Food Security and Humanitarian Phase Classification (Valid until 31.08.2007) in Cambodia (As of 26.02.2007)

B. Environmental Degradation

F. Lack of income diversification  
G. Poor Access to Health Care Services  
H. Disease (HIV/AIDS, TB, Malaria, etc.)  
I. Poor road and communication infrastructure  
J. UXO/mines Contamination  
K. Insecurity of entitlements  
L. External shocks
