**RESULTS:** 

R1. Capacity in FS analysis and classification, using standardized approach, is strengthened at national and regional level

R2. Standardized analysis of fs is available in each project country and integrated into regional and global analysis

R3. IPC multi-stakeholder approach is well integrated into existing fs analytical systems, institutions and structures, and IPC products are utilised as part of normal fs analysis in the countries
